Here are some interesting statistics concerning Super 14 Rugby competition 2007. The stats have been made through games analysis across the season from February until April 2007. This information was compiled before the final phase of the competition.

21 games were used to calculate the average of stoppages per game, 12 games for the average Actual Game Time, scrums and lineouts.

The following table resumes the statistics:

Average AGT	Average Stoppages per game	Average time per stoppage	Action Time	Average number of Scrums	Average number of Lineouts
43%	84	34 seconds	Average: 13 seconds Max: 90 seconds	19	35

The calculation for the average time per stoppage was made through the Actual Game Time. The average work/rest ratio is in the range of 1:2.5
